Even in my mind, give me the grace to dwell on what is beautiful and worthy of praise. Help me always to live with the Spirit of Truth and Love impressed upon my mind, for the good of my soul and my neighbor. I ask also the grace to see myself and all I meet through the eyes of Your Eternal Love and Truth. Hail Mary...
